ZyQuest Breaks Ground for New Office Building

Green Bay, WI – Information technology company ZyQuest, Inc., has broken ground for a new office building.

Designed by architectural firm Millennium Architects, the new building will be located in the Ashwaubenon Business Centre, 1385 West Main Avenue, De Pere. Jacob C. Basten Construction Co., Inc., will be serving as contractor for the project.

ZyQuest decided to build the new 13,000-square-foot structure to accommodate its growing business, according to ZyQuest president Al Zeise. Named in *Inc.* magazine's year 2000 list of the 500 fastest growing companies in America, ZyQuest currently employs nearly 100 information technology consultants and support workers. About a third of those employees are expected to work out of the new office building, which will house ZyQuest's corporate offices and the Development Center, ZyQuest's in-house software development facility.

In addition to ZyQuest, the new building will provide office space for ZyTax, LLC and Advanced Technical Solutions.

The foundation for the building will be poured later this month. The building's anticipated completion date is April 2005.

Currently headquartered in the Cellcom Building in De Pere, ZyQuest, Inc., is a full-service information technology consulting company offering a broad range of IT services, including staff augmentation, project management and outsourcing, Internet solutions, and technical education.
