## **ZYQUEST WINS STATE ENERGY-MONITORING PROJECT**

Green Bay, WI – ZyQuest, Inc., in conjunction with Clean Power Markets, Inc., has been awarded a Wisconsin State project to develop a Renewable Resource Credit (RRC) system for the state's 120 electric providers.

Called the "Wisconsin Renewable Resource Credit Trading Program", the project grew out of the requirements of the 1999 Wisconsin Act 9. The Act mandates that a certain percentage of electricity come from renewable resources, such as wind, hydro, geothermal, and biomass. Some companies generate more renewable energy than they need to meet the State requirements. This extra energy can be turned into "credits" that can be traded to companies that don't produce enough energy from renewable sources. Keeping track of those credits is the job of the RRC system that ZyQuest will be developing.

Working with ZyQuest on the project will be Clean Power Markets, Inc. of California, which specializes in tracking and trading renewable energy credits. Project lead and ZyQuest consultant Renee Landwehr commented that the "green market" expertise of Clean Power Markets is a good fit with ZyQuest's software development know-how.

The State project was awarded through the Electric Division of the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin. Landwehr estimates that the project should be completed by February of next year.
