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ZyQuest Moves to New Office Building

Green Bay, WI – Six months after breaking ground, Information Technology company ZyQuest, Inc., moved into its new office building on Friday, May 27, 2005.

Designed by architectural firm Millennium Architects, the new building is located in the Ashwaubenon Business Centre, 1385 West Main Avenue, De Pere. Jacob C. Basten Construction Co., Inc., served as contractor for the project.

ZyQuest decided to build the new 13,000-square-foot structure to accommodate its growing business, according to ZyQuest president Al Zeise. Named in *Inc.* magazine's year 2000 list of the 500 fastest growing companies in America, ZyQuest currently employs more than 100 information technology consultants and support workers. About a fourth of those employees are working out of the new office building, which houses ZyQuest's corporate offices and ZyQuest's in-house software Development Center.

In addition, the new building includes a training facility, which will be used for advanced technical education. Classes will be provided in conjunction with ZyQuest's education partner, Binary Training, Inc.

The new building will also provide office space for ZyTax, LLC. Originally a subsidiary of ZyQuest, ZyTax was formed in 1999 to promote the fuel excise tax software developed by ZyQuest. ZyTax was purchased by the Texas-based company, FuelQuest, Inc., in 2001.

To celebrate the new building, ZyQuest will host an open house for all company clients, consultants, and friends on June 15 from 4 P.M. to 7 P.M.
